### 4. CSR ACTIVITIES OF BCCL

Bharat Coking Coal Limited (BCCL) is committed to good corporate citizenship and makes constant efforts to build and nurture long lasting relationships with members of the society in general and it's peripheral communities in particular.

BCCL is taking up activities from the HQ level and through its administrative areas for the implementation of CSR activities. For this purpose A CSR cell is functioning which is headed by General Manger(Welfare) under the direct control of Director(Personnel) of the company.

The CSR activities are specific to the village, depending on the need assessed for the people by local Hon'ble M.Ps and M.L.As. Further as suggested by the MOEF Committee, a detailed project specific CSR Action Plan.shall be formulated and for this purpose, BCCL has approached TATA INSTITUTE AND SOCIAL SCIENCES, MUMBAI which is also the focal agency of the National CSR Hub. ### The CSR activities presently being done by BCCL

- To meet the acute shortage of drinking water in peripheral villages' drinking Water is provided through deep borewells, tubewells, pumps/motors, in the peripheral villages of BCCL. Water supply through pipeline, through water tanker is provided also to the villages.
- Education: BCCL adopts a multi-pronged approach to promote quality education in backward areas. The measures taken by BCCL comprise Construction, Extension, and Renovation of school buildings etc are done to promote quality education in the nearby villages. BCCL is Extending financial aid for educational facilities to 83 nos. Private Committee Managed schools. Measures are taken to promote women literacy and carrier development.
- Health Care: BCCL Conducts medical/health camps for dwellers of peripheral villages
  for rendering free medical consultancy. CSR Clinics, wellness clinics, artificial limbs
  centers are organized for the benefit of the needy section of the society.. Mobile
  medical vans are deployed as special arrangement for medical services. AIDS
  awareness camps are organized as special drive to develop awareness and to render
  free consultancy. In Kusunda Area many medical /health camps in peripheral villages
  and in collieries and various awareness programmes have already been conducted,

  Council (CIDC), New Delhi, a body promoted by Planning Commission, on 20.03.2012
  for employment linked training program in the Construction Sector for poor and
  downtrodden people of the Jharia coalfield including project affected persons and fire
  affected people. BCCL in coordination with the CIDC is identifying the project affected
  persons to undergo the required training programs to be conducted by CIDC.

In case of placement below 75%, pro rata payment is to be made. All training are mandatorily residential. In the year 2012-13 5000 youths will be trained and in the subsequent years no. Of trainees will be scaled up @ 15% per annum.

### STATUS OF JHARIA MASTER PLAN DOVETAILED WITH ENVIRONMENT CLEARANCE CONDITIONS

### Rehabilitation and Fire control measures

### Socio-economic Survey:

Out of total 595 nos. of fire affected / subsidence prone sites / areas to be surveyed, CIMFR, ISM, whiz Mantra and JRDA have completed demographic / socio-economic survey of 369 sites in which 39502 families have been identified. Photo Identity Cards (PICs) are completed for 24076 families till 31.05.2013.

About 35 nos. Fire affected areas in Kusunda Area are under JRDA Survey.

### Accommodation provided in Satellite Township:

- 2352 houses have been constructed in Belgoria rehabilitation Township "Jharia Vihar" in which
- 1161 families have shifted till 31-05-2013. Progress is very slow since July, 2012.
- 1137 nos. of affected families have each been handed over cheque amounting to Rs.10,000/- as shifting allowance.
- 1041 nos. of families have been given 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> payment of minimum wages of 250 days, whereas 299 nos. of families have been given 3rd & 4th last instalment totalling to 500 days.
- At East Bassuriya permanent rehabilitation site, 600 quarters are in construction. Out of 600, 278 qtrs.have been allotted of employees residing in coal bearing zone of diff.collieries under Kusunda Area.
- In temporary rehabilitation site at decoaled zone of East Bassuriya about 13 PAF have been shifted.

JRDA is unable to shift non-BCCL persons/ encroachers from endangered and fiery zones under the approved Master Plan, due to non-availability of houses / land for rehabilitation. BCCL has decided to temporarily shift those persons (whose socio-economic survey has been done by JRDA) to 'Reclaimed Sites' in various collieries of BCCL. For the purpose, BCCL has already selected 47.84 Acres land in non-fire zones

### **Transfer of land to JRDA by BCCL:**

86.44 acres of vacant land in Bhuli Township and 849.68 acres of non-coal bearing land in and around Belgoria Township belonging to BCCL have been identified for developing new Townships by JRDA. NOC for transferring the land to JRDA has been given by MoC which has been communicated to JRDA vide letter no. D(T):OP:F-24/11/502 dated 30.09.11/3.10.11. BCCL has provided all the required mouza plans with details to JRDA vide letter no. 944, dated 16.12.2011 and No.964, dated 17.12.2011 In response to letter no.365, dated 27.5.13 issued by DC-cum-Project Director, JRDA, BCCL proposed one time dispensation for release of 372 employments for physical possession of entire land for which NoC has been given to JRDA. Said proposal is agreed by BCCL Board and also forwarded to CIL for obtaining permission from MoC, Govt. of India.

### Welfare Programme:

Various welfare training and employment generation programmes are being organised with the help/aid of Nari Shakti of BCCL for rehabilitated families at Belgoria Townships viz.

- (i) Distribution of 14 Rickshaws, 8 business tri-cycles, 8 tricycles, 6 wheel chairs and 5 baishakhis to the needy persons.
- (ii) 1500 blankets were distributed in winter seasons.
- (iii) 80 women are getting stitching training in 4 batches.
- (iv) Adult education programme are also being conducted. 60 persons are covered uptill now.
- (v) A Self Help Group comprising of ladies of nine families headed by Kanak Lata Singh is making paper pouches from the donated old newspapers of BCCL township at Belgoria. They prepare about 250 kg. paper pouches in the month and sell at the rate of Rs.20/- per kg earning Rs.5000/- per month.
- (vi) 2000 study materials viz. note-books, pencils, pens, erasers have recently been distributed to the rehabilitated students to promote education amongst them.

An MoU has been signed on 20.03.2013, followed by an agreement on 15.04.2013 between BCCL and CIDC for engaging Construction Industry Development Council (CIDC), New Delhi for employment linked training programme in construction sector etc. for project affected persons (PAPs) using CSR funds. It is a programme that around 5000 (Five thousands) persons shall be given training through CIDC in the year 2013-14. The MoU and Agreement have been approved by BCCL Board of Directors

### Status of fire dealing:

Under Master Plan, total 28 nos. of Fire schemes have been proposed in Phase-I to be formulated / prepared for dealing with 67 fires sites spread in 41 collieries. Till date 11 fire schemes have been approved by Board and implemented, out of which 4 nos. of schemes have been completed and rest are under different stages of execution. Three more fire Schemes are under preparation at CMPDIL. Further for expediting the fire dealing process, excavation methods has been resorted to by deploying Hired HEMM at

various mines of BCCL. For this, the expenditure is being made from its own revenue budget.

BCCL approached NRSC for conducting fresh survey of fires and subsidence by remote sensing methods in January 2013.NRSC has sent the proposals for coal fire mapping of Jharia coalfield using thermal infra-red data for the cost of Rs.6,70,721.00 and land subsidence mapping of Jharia coalfield using Inter-ferometic SAR data for a cost of Rs. 12,98,571.00. As an advance action, BCCL has approved both the proposals and requested NRSC to submit invoice for Rs. 17.73 lacs (90% of the total cost) vide letter no.BCCL/HOD (Env ) /F-MP/610 dated 21.05.13.

A MoU is to be entered with the NRSC for start of the work. For this purpose, duly signed MOU from our end has been sent to NRSC for necessary processing at their end and to start the work immediately. Meanwhile NRSC is mobilising the scientists and other preparatory work to start the survey.

Against the earmarked amount of Rs.2311 crores, an amount of Rs.16 crores has been disbursed to BCCL for control of fires. Now an amount of Rs.2295 crores remains under the approved Jharia Master Plan unspent for fire control measures.

It is proposed by BCCL vide letter no.BCCL/CMD/Sr.ES/F-2(A)/12/274, dated 2<sup>nd</sup> Aug., 2012 that this amount of Rs.2295 crores can be re-appropriated till the RE crosses the amount for facilitating the following various activities for implementation of rehabilitation of families from endangered areas as per the approved Master Plan:

- (a) in enhancing the size of the rehabilitation houses / carpet area from Indira Awas Yojana type to JNNURM housing norms.
- (b) in meeting the financial impact on account of increase in the number of endangered families after actual demographic survey.
- (c) in meeting the appreciation of price of land acquisition etc.

This will enable in accelerating in the implementation of Jharia Master Plan.

Under Master Plan, Fire Patch of V/VI/VII/VIII seam at Gareria Section of East Bassuriya, Kusunda Area have been filled up with about 1,70,000 cu.m of mitti, rest will be filled up by quarry OB of Patch A of East Bassuriya OC.

At Kusunda Colliery, total firey coal are being digged out as a measure of fire dealing. For control and monitoring of threat of subsidence at fire affected area within Godhur lease hold special attention has been made by mine management. Director of CIMFR, Dhanbad has been requested for scientific study for formulating time schedule of work to prevent propagation of fire. JRDA has completed survey the basties at fire affected area for evacuation & rehabilitation of the inhabitants under Jharia Action Plan and has prepared approx.250 no. Identity Cards. Colliery Management have allotted quarters at other safe place to 41(approx.) employees residing at/near fire affected areafor their early evacuation. Besides,

one special team headed by senior mine official has been made at Colliery for inspection/supervision of the lease hold area of Godhur for early detection of any pot hole, fume and report to mine management for early action.

Creation of water bodies in coal bearing area will pose safety threats to nearby mine and if will be violation of mines act. This will also create grave danger of inundation of the adjacent mines since the mines are 100 years old and interconnected with each other. So this action cannot be complied.

However to catch run-off water in colonies proposal for Rain water Harvesting in two colonies is under process

### (6) Dealing of mine fires

A Master plan for Dealing with fires and subsidence and rehabilitation in the Leasehold of BCCL has been approved by Govt. of India vide letter no- 22020/1/2005-CRC dated 12 08 09 with estimated cost of Rs. 7112.11 crores. In fire patch of V/VI/VII/VIII seam of Gareria Secn. at East Bassuriya about 1,70,000 cu.m. mitti has been filled, rest will be filled by quarry OB of Patch A.

In Kusunda OC, fire patch is being dug out for the purpose of dealing with fire and combustible materials are extracted out to save the coal from burning and to stop further spread of the fire. Once the fiery coal is dug-out/excavated there will be no more chance of re-starting of fresh/ spreading of fire into other areas.

At Alkusa mine, measures have been taken as per CMR'57 and DGMS Guidelines to control ug fire.
