  - 3.1. Part-I: 60% Payment on Submission of Draft Report.
  - 3.2. Part-II: 40% on Final Submission of Report.
  - 3.3. Total lump sum contract price, inclusive of incidental expenses and out-of-pocket expenses, shall be ₹ 2,05,00,000.00+ ₹ 36,90,000.00 (GST @ 18%) amounting to ₹ **2,41,90,000.00 (Rupees Two Crore Forty One Lakh Ninety Thousand Only).**
