 - In the event of failure to deliver the stores within the stipulated date/ period in accordance with the samples and/or specification mentioned is the supply order, and in the event of breach of any terms and conditions mentioned in the supply order Bharat Coking Coal Limited reserves the right:
 - a) To recover from you, as agreed liquidated damages, a sum not less than 0.5% (half percentage) of the price of the stores which you have not been able to supply (for this purpose part of a unit supplied will not be considered) as aforesaid for each week or part of a week during which the delivery of such stores may be in arrears limited to 10%. Where felt necessary the limit of 10% can be increased to 15% at the discretion of Head of the Materials Management Division.
 - b) To purchase elsewhere, after due notice to you, on your account and risk, the stores not supplied or others of a similar description without canceling the supply order in respect of consignment not yet due for supply or
 - c) To cancel the supply order or a portion thereof, and if so desired to purchase the store at your risk and cost and also
 - d) To extend the period of delivery with or without penalty as may be considered fit and proper. The penalty, if imposed shall not be more than the agreed liquidated damages referred to in clause (a) above.
 - e) To encash any Bank guarantee which is available for recovery of the penalty or
 - f) To forfeit the security deposit full or in part.
 - g) Whenever under the contract a sum of money is recoverable from and payable by you, BCCL shall be entitled to recover such sum by appropriating, in part or whole by deducting any sum or which at any time thereafter may be due you in this or any other contract with Bharat Coking Coal Ltd. or any subsidiary of Coal India Ltd. - ii. If at any time during the said period the supplier offers lower sale price of such stores to any other organization at a price lower than the price chargeable under this contract, the supplier shall forthwith notify such reduction or sale to the consignee concerned under intimation to CGM(MM), Bharat Coking Coal Limited, Commercial Block, Level -III, Koyla Bhawan, Koyla Nagar, Dhanbad and the price payable under the contract for the stores supplied after the date of coming into force of such reduction or sale, shall stand correspondingly reduced. The above stipulated will not, however apply to exports by the supplier.

All other terms & conditions along with Technical Specifications and Scope of supply will strictly be as per our NIT and company's norms.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR ENGINEERING WIRE ROPES

- 1) <u>COLOR CODING</u>: The firm should confirm that, for purpose of identification, one strand of the rope will be coloured <u>PALE YELLOW</u> at no extra cost to the consignee. Alternatively, a <u>PALE YELLOW</u> tape / thread of PVC with brand name/name of manufacturer written in <u>RED colour</u> on the same may be put for identification.
- 2) <u>GUARANTEE/WARRANTY</u>: The firm should confirm a warranty in respect of sub-standard materials, poor workmanship and faulty design (excluding normal wear & tear) for a period of 12 months from date of fitment or 18 months from the date of receipt at Central Stores, whichever is earlier. Defective wire-ropes shall have to be replaced free of cost and shall have to be completed within one month from the date of claim. All cases of warranty replacement shall be decided on the basis of joint inspection of the failed rope held between the user's representative and manufacturer's representative.
- 3) <u>DELIVERY:</u> Supply to be made in two phases. 1st phase of 50% quantity to be supplied within 90 days from the date of receipt of order and 2nd phase of rest 50% quantity to be supplied within 180 days of receipt of order.

- All ropes to be lubricated with suitable grease/lubricants.
- c) All the ropes to be coiled in wooden reels covered with plastic or any water resistant materials and tied with gunny /hessian and tied properly with manila rope.
- d) The flange of the ropes should be adequately protected to prevent damages during transition of the materials.
- e) The diameter of the reels should not exceed 1.5 m and weight within 5 tonnes.
- f) All the reels to be marked with the particulars of the rope, like dia, name of the manufacturers, construction detail, tare weight, gross weight, etc.
- 5) <u>AFTER SALES SERVICE</u>: The firm should confirm that after sales service will be provided as and when required by the end users.
