6. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES CLAUSE:

8. WARRANTY: Materials supplied should be guaranteed for a period of 12 (twelve) months from the date of installation and commissioning or 18 (eighteen) months from the date of receipt and acceptance at the consignee end, whichever is earlier against any manufacturing defects/workmanship/inferior quality.

The guarantee/composite warranty shall be submitted along with the bill. The warranty shall cover for the total equipment so that the necessity of having to approach different manufacturers of various components/assemblies does not arise and all services under warranty clause shall be the responsibility of the ultimate supplier of the composite equipment.
